MINUTES

- ◆ **Call to Order:** Tom Sommers called the Remington Unified School District 206 Board of Education Meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. on April 9, 2018 at the Remington District Office, 110 South Main, Whitewater, Kansas.
- ◆ **Members Present:** Tom Sommers; President, Kendall Claassen; Vice President, members, Jayne Carey, Doug Claassen, Brad Crisp, Jeff Klaassen, and Penny McNeill
- ◆ **Members Absent:** None
- ◆ **Others Present:** James Regier, Martina Bumm, Tim Bumgarner, Tammy Sweatland, Bob Friesen, Jason Smith Sr., Jason Smith Jr., Kevin Wise, Patricia Fee, Daniel Fee, and Craig Fee
- ◆ **Opportunity to Add Agenda Items:** Added item #6A – Out of District Students
- ◆ **Approval of Additions and Agenda:** Motion to approve additions and agenda. (Crisp), seconded (McNeill), carried 7-0.
- ◆ **Consent Agenda:** Motion to approve all items on the consent agenda. (D. Claassen), seconded (K. Claassen), carried 7-0.
- ◆ **Patrons Open Forum:** No patrons requested to address the board.
- ◆ **Principals Reports:**
 - ◆ **Tim Bumgarner (RHS):**
 - Parent/Teacher conferences were attended by 77% of parents, this is up from 72% last year.
 - HOA Art Contest was held on Apr 4th at Inman. RHS art students received a total of 19 ribbons.
 - KSHAA Music Festival was held Apr 7th at Butler County Comm. College, RHS vocalists performed well.
 - Grant Janzen, RHS senior, was the overall champion at the KS 3A Powerlifting State Meet.
 - RHS Prom will be held Apr 14th @ 8 pm.
 - RHS Choir will be travelling to Denver and will leave on May 3rd.
 - Graduation will be held Saturday, May 12th @ 11a.m. Tom Sommers and Brad Crisp will represent the Board of Education.
 - ◆ **Bob Friesen (RMS):**
 - 5th graders visited a farm with related PBL activities, 6th graders visited The Museum of World Treasures, and 8th graders will be traveling to the Salt Museum in Hutchinson, attending the MCC Sale, and participating in a civic engagement (collecting school supplies and hygiene products).
 - Parent/Teacher conferences were attended by 73% of parents.
 - RMS 7th grade Quiz Bowl team placed 1st and 8th grade Quiz Bowl team placed 3rd at the HOA League tournament at Hutch Trinity on Apr 3rd.
 - Jensen Wiebe qualified for the World History Bee in Berlin Germany, but does not plan on attending.
 - 42 students are out for track. The first meet was held at Hillsboro on Mar 29th and the second meet was held at RHS on Apr 5th. RMS will be hosting the HOA League track meet next year at RHS.
 - 8th grade promotion will be held Mon. May 14th @ 7pm. Penny McNeill will represent the Board of Education.

Tammy Sweatland (RES):

- 92% of parents attended the student led parent/teacher conferences.
- ELA state assessments have been completed, math assessments will be taken next.
- Upcoming field trips include: Pre-K-zoo, 1st grade – zoo, 2nd grade-Rock & Minerals Show, and 4th grade – Salt Museum in Hutch.
- Market Day will be held Apr 27th from 10am – 11am and 2pm – 3 pm.
- Field Day will be held May 4th.
- 4th grade orientation at RMS will be held May 9th.

- ◆ **Student Handbook Changes:** Motion to approve student handbook changes for RMS and RES as presented. (D. Claassen), seconded (Carey), carried 7-0.
- ◆ **Capital Outlay Expenditures:** Motion to approve capital outlay expenditures for each building as presented. (Crisp), seconded (K. Claassen), carried 7-0.
- ◆ **Grant Acceptance:** Motion to accept grant from Kansas State Department of Education in the amount of \$300 to cover the cost of 3 health/PE teachers to attend a wellness class in Clearwater on March 1, 2018. (K. Claassen), seconded (D. Claassen), carried 7-0.
- ◆ **Superintendent Report:**
 - Remington High School Roof – A portion of the RHS roof was damaged due to high winds and has been totaled by the adjuster. Mr. Regier is still waiting to hear how much of the roof repair will be covered by the insurance company.
 - Gemini II Vote – Mr. Regier shared that 97.7% of teachers voted to go forward with the Gemini II Redesign Project.
 - Remington Outside Visitation Team – The OVT visit on 3/15/18 went well. The district received positive reviews from the team (consisting of 3 other school districts).
 - Interview Architects for possible Bond Issue – The school board will hold architect interviews on Apr 23rd at 7pm at the district office.
- ◆ **Executive Session:** Motion to go into Executive Session at 8:04 p.m. to discuss hiring and resignations pursuant to non-elected exception under KOMA, and the open meeting will resume in the board room at 8:20 p.m. (Carey), seconded (McNeill). Board returned to open session at 8:20 p.m. Motion to extend Executive Session until 8:30 p.m. (McNeill), seconded (Carey), carried 7-0. Board returned to open session at 8:30 p.m. Motion to extend Executive Session until 8:40 p.m. (McNeill), seconded (Crisp), carried 7-0. Board returned to open session at 8:40 p.m.
- ◆ **Action from Executive Session:** Motion to approve hiring (2018-2019 school year) of Darrin Rasmussen as RHS Industrial Arts Teacher, Simon McKee as RMS Social Studies Teacher and RHS Head Football Coach, Madison Gehrer as RES Teacher and Carrie Unruh as RES Teacher (Carey), seconded (Crisp), carried 7-0.

Motion to accept the resignations (at the end of the 2017-2018 school year) of Rochelle Dickson as RES 3rd grade teacher, Darrin Rasmussen as RMS Social Studies Teacher, Megan Kellner as RES 4th grade teacher, Ben Wertenberger as RHS Mathematics Teacher, Jim Graham as RHS Assistant Custodian, and Emily Merritt as RHS 3rd cook. (D. Claassen), seconded (K. Claassen), carried 7-0.
- ◆ **Adjournment:** Motion to adjourn at 8:45 p.m. (Crisp), seconded (McNeill), carried 7-0.
